Routine prenatal care

We're often asked how many office visits are needed over the course of a pregnancy. For routine prenatal visits, the typical schedule is as follows:

Early pregnancy consultation

First ultrasound, followed by a visit with one of our nurse practitioners

Genetic screening, if desired (between 10 and 13 weeks, please call 312.472.4151 to schedule)

One visit every four weeks between 12 and 36 weeks (12, 16, 20, 24, 28, 32, 36 weeks)

At 38 weeks

At 39 weeks

At 40 weeks
