Routine prenatal care

For routine prenatal visits, the typical schedule is as follows:

Early pregnancy consultation

Visit with a nurse practitioner

Genetic screening, if desired (between 10 and 13 weeks, please call 312.472.4151 to schedule)

One visit every 4 weeks between 12 and 36 weeks (12, 16, 20, 24, 28, 32, 36 weeks)

At 38 weeks

At 39 weeks

At 40 weeks
